

Nominations/Elections for School Year 2010-2011

The nomination ballot is attached.

Here are the guidelines to be nominated for officer/chairperson and/or voting (all nominations must be made in writing up to two weeks before the election):

To be nominated for the office of President, Vice President, Assistant Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer of the GPTO:

1. You must be a member of the GPTO and paid membership dues at least three months before the election meeting.
2. You must have served as a committee chairperson or existing officer and must have attended at least three general or committee meetings and three board meetings during the current school year to be nominated.

To run for chairperson of a committee – Committee's include Membership and Marketing, Social, Guardian Ambassadors, Building and Grounds, Fundraising:

1. You must be a member of the GPTO and paid membership dues at least three months before the election meeting.
2. You must have been an active member of a committee and must have attended at least three general or committee meetings during the current school year.
3. Each committee will have two chairpersons elected through the nomination process.
4. Each committee will have a Secretary and Fiscal Manager elected by the respective committee.

To be eligible to vote for officers and chairpersons of a committee:

1. You must be a parent, guardian or other adult standing in loco parentis for a student of the school.
2. You must be a paid member of the GPTO at least 14 calendar days before the election meeting.
3. You must have attended at least three general or committee meetings during the current school year.
4. Absentee ballots are available upon written request to the Nominating Committee. Any member in good standing who has a valid reason for not being able to attend the election meeting can request one. Requests must be made at least two weeks prior to the election meeting, and ballots must be returned at least 24 hours before the meeting.
