The middle school teachers have adopted the following homework policy commencing the beginning of the second quarter, November 4.

If a student forgets a homework assignment, he or she will see Mrs. Kozick. After three missed assignments, the student will receive a detention. Please note, the three missed assignments may be from different teachers; they do not have to be assignments from the same teacher. After three detentions, the student will receive an in-school suspension. While we do not anticipate the problem to continue beyond this point, if it does and the student habitually receives in-school suspensions, it will lead to further action to be determined by the Good Shepherd Administration.

Homework provides ongoing communication between home and school. The assigned homework reinforces the day's learning; it is an enhancement of the day's activities and an integral part of the learning and retaining process.
