

TUITION REDUCTION INCENTIVE

2011 – 2012 School Year

The Diocese of Scranton has introduced the Tuition Reduction Incentive Program for the start of the 2011-2012 School Year. This means that the Tuition and the \$500.00 mandatory fundraising that was done in the past has been combined into the tuition for the first child in each family and you will no longer be billed separately. Your participation in the Tuition Incentives listed below will go toward reducing your 2011-2012 Tuition payment. The Tuition Reduction Incentives have no limit. **Only** the tuition incentives listed below will reduce the payments and you are under no obligation to participate in any of them.

Race for Education (Family will receive 70% credit toward tuition reduction)

Gertrude Hawk Christmas & Easter Sale (Families will receive a % TBA depending on group sales)

Candle Sale (Families will receive \$3.00 & \$5.00 per candle depending on size)

Lottery July, August, Oct. Dec. Feb. April (Families will receive \$3.00 toward tuition reduction)

Flower Sale (Christmas & Easter) Credit depends on cost of item

Pierogi Sale (Christmas & Easter) Credit depends on cost of item

Krispy Kreme Doughnuts (Credit depends on cost of item)

Thanksgiving Pie & Nut Roll Sale (Credit depends on cost of item)

Voucher Credits - Just as in the past parents can continue to apply Voucher credits from the Gift Certificate Program to reduce their tuition payment .

For your participation in a Tuition incentive you will receive a TR CARD (Tuition Reduction Card) with the amount of your credit. At anytime **you** choose you can send the TR Card to the finance office at Good Shepherd Academy and that amount will be reduced from your FACTS tuition payment. The TR cards do not expire. If you paid your 2011-12 Tuition in full you can begin to accumulate the TR Cards for the following school year.

Tuition credit will be applied at the school where the event occurs until the entire tuition amount at that school is earned. Once your tuition responsibility at one school is satisfied, we will work with you to transfer the credit to another school or save the credit for the following school year. **Please note at no time is tuition reduction credit redeemable for cash.**
