

Talent Show Guidelines

Tuesday, January 31, 2012

Talent show is open to any student currently in grades 5-8.

Students may sing, dance, play an instrument, perform a monologue, etc. All acts must be age-appropriate for an audience of Pre-K to 8. All vocal music should be memorized.

Any student who has a “specialty”, i.e. juggling, etc., may sign up to be “filler” in between spot performers.

Students who plan to sing, and want piano accompaniment, must bring sheet music, and arrange rehearsal time w/accompanist (Mr. Hanlon, Mrs. Motyka, or other students).

All dancers must bring their own CDs. If any other music source is needed, i.e. i-pod dock, etc, students must bring their own.

The talent show will be held on the gym floor, therefore, no tap shoes will be allowed directly on the floor. If students own a portable performing “mat”, please clear this with Mr. Jones (the stage is not an option, as there will not be time to set up chairs on the gym floor due to basketball). Dancers are encouraged to perform another form of dance routine.

Auditions, if needed, will be held the week of January 23, time to be announced. Judges will be from outside of the school.
