- <u>Required</u>: With a thin marker/pen, write <u>student's name</u> directly on the device, or write name on a piece of tape, like masking or duct, then attach tape securely to device. The name should be visible.
- <u>Note</u>: Please send in flash drives that are indistinct, like the one pictured to the right. Flash drives that look like toys (e.g.: Sponge Bob, superheroes, unicorns, etc.) cause problems especially when trying to put them in the USB ports.
